



RCPSC Subspecialist Examination Affiliate Program Route to Licensure Policy

This policy outlines the minimum requirements for obtaining a Provisional Licence – Specialty Practice through the Royal College of Physician and Surgeons of Canada’s (RCPSC) Subspecialist Examination Affiliate Program (SEAP).

Scope:

This policy focuses specifically on specialist applicants who are applying for licensure through the RCPSC’s SEAP.

Policy:

In addition to meeting all other licensing criteria, an applicant for a Provisional Licence – Specialty Practice via the RCPSC’s SEAP must:

1. Successfully complete the RCPSC subspecialty examination through the SEAP program; and
2. Provide proof of Royal College Subspecialist Affiliate status in their subspecialty.

Physicians issued a Licence to Practice Medicine through this policy shall be restricted in scope to their subspecialty as recognized by their RCPSC Subspecialty Affiliate status.
