Dear Healthcare Professional:

Following our authorization of two COVID-19 vaccines in December, we are now closely monitoring their post-market safety and effectiveness. As part of our commitment to keep Canadians informed, we are publishing information about adverse events following immunization (AEFI) and would like to share with you and your members the new <u>Adverse events following immunization (AEFI) for COVID-19 vaccines report</u>. This report, which will be updated on a weekly basis, includes information about cases received by the Public Health Agency of Canada's Canadian Adverse Events Following Immunization Surveillance System (CAEFISS) and Health Canada's Canada Vigilance program.

Please visit Health Canada's <u>COVID-19 vaccines and treatments regulatory portal</u> to access the information for patients and healthcare professionals for all authorized COVID-19 vaccines and treatments.
