Notice to College Members

September 10, 2021

Key Application Changes for 2022:

- Confirmation that you have completed the course “*Providing Culturally Safe Health Care for Indigenous Patients in Newfoundland and Labrador*” (MDCME.ca). You will be required to provide your course certificate number on the application.
- Confirmation that you have engaged in medical practice for a minimum of 120 days in the 36 month period prior to the renewal of your licence (January 16, 2022)

Timeline and Process:

- October 4, 2021 – **Licence Renewal 2022 opens**
- December 1, 2021 - To guarantee that the legislated January 15 deadline for licence renewal is met, physicians must submit a fully completed renewal application, pay the annual fee, and provide any supporting material requested by the College no later than **December 1, 2021**
- December 2, 2021 – January 15, 2022
 - Application process remains open
 - Late fee applied beginning December 2, 2021
 - Applications received after December 1, 2021 have no guarantee of being renewed prior to January 16, 2022
- January 16, 2022
 - Licence Renewal 2022 closes at 24:00 hrs on January 15, 2022
 - Licence reinstatement fee applied beginning January 16, 2022
