



REMINDER – OPPORTUNITY: PHYSICIAN PEER REVIEWER (FAMILY MEDICINE)

Notice to College Members

March 18, 2022

Under the *Medical Act, 2011*, the College is required to administer a program of peer review. The College is currently seeking experienced Family Medicine physicians with a demonstrated commitment to life-long learning to act as Peer Reviewers with its Physician Peer Review program (PPR-NL). The position is contractual and will be renewed on an annual basis. As a member of a dedicated quality improvement team, you will conduct peer assessments on behalf of the College starting in May, 2022.

The position is contractual and will be renewed on an annual basis. The role will require approximately 4 hours of effort per week (one half day), 35 to 40 weeks per year.

Peer Reviewers will:

- conduct assessments of physicians' practices and make recommendations to improve patient care;
- use standardized assessment tools to provide physicians with meaningful feedback, to support reflection on practice; and,
- assist CPSNL and physicians identify relevant practice resources.

Peer Reviewers will work with the support of the College's staff and medical advisor and will be provided with training to support them in their role.

Peer Reviewers will be compensated at a rate approved by the Council of the College, as well as for any related travel and expenses.
