



# EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST: DISCIPLINARY PANEL MEMBERS

## Notice to College Members

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January 18, 2023

Council is seeking interest from members who wish to be considered for appointment to the Disciplinary Panel of the College. Information regarding this opportunity is detailed below.

### **Role of Disciplinary Panel Member**

When a complaint is referred for a hearing, the Chair of the Disciplinary Panel will appoint three members to sit on the Adjudication Tribunal. The Adjudication Tribunal will preside over the hearing and render a decision in relation to the complaint.

### **Time Commitment**

The time commitment varies depending on the number of complaints referred for hearings each year and the length of each hearing. Hearings take place during business hours and are scheduled for a minimum of a half day but can last more than five days. Some hearings are virtual, while others are in-person.

### **Remuneration**

Members who serve on a tribunal are reimbursed for travel expenses and are remunerated for their service as a tribunal member for each day of the hearing and time involved in reaching a decision.

All College communication to its members will be by email. It is a professional obligation for College members to read all College communications.

### **Term of Appointment**

Members are appointed for a term of three years and can be re-appointed.

### **Selection Criteria**

Members are appointed to ensure diversity of the panel in respect of a number of criteria including practice location (rural/urban) and area of practice.

### **How to Submit an Expression of Interest**

Candidates who are appointed will be notified by email following the March 2023 meeting of Council.
