Your input will inform the Standards of Practice and ensure that they reflect current practice issues, embody the duties of medical professionalism, and are consistent with the College's mandate to act in the public interest.

[Medical Records Documentation & Management](#)

Medical records contain valuable information about a patient's clinical history and interactions with healthcare providers. This Standard sets out the College's expectations of physicians in respect of the creation, retention, and storage of medical records.

[Prescribing & Dispensing of Medications](#)

Prescribing and dispensing medication requires appropriate knowledge, skill, and judgment. This Standard sets out the College's expectations for physicians who prescribe medication. It also sets out the limited circumstances in which a physician can dispense medications and the College's expectations for physicians who engage in this practice.
