Notice to College Members

A reminder that the College is seeking feedback on two revised Standards of Practice. We welcome your professional opinion as we assess the College's expectations of physicians on the topics of Medical Records Documentation & Management and Prescribing & Dispensing of Medications.

Your input will inform the Standards of Practice and ensure that they reflect current practice issues, embody the duties of medical professionalism, and are consistent with the College's mandate to act in the public interest.

Medical Records Documentation & Management

Medical records contain valuable information about a patient's clinical history and interactions with healthcare providers. This Standard sets out the College's expectations of physicians in respect of the creation, retention, and storage of medical records.

Prescribing & Dispensing of Medications

Prescribing and dispensing medication requires appropriate knowledge, skill, and judgment. This Standard sets out the College's expectations for physicians who prescribe medication. It also sets out the limited circumstances in which a physician can dispense medications and the College's expectations for physicians who engage in this practice.
