



2023 COUNCIL ELECTIONS CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Notice to College Members

October 18, 2023

The College is holding an election from November 8 to December 1, 2023, to fill one (1) seat on Council.

In accordance with the *Medical Act, 2011*, this seat is in the medical electoral division representing the remainder of the province (i.e., outside the region comprising the City of Mount Pearl and the City of St. John's).

Who is eligible to run and vote?

To be eligible to run for election and vote for a candidate, a physician must:

- Hold a full or provisional Licence to Practice Medicine in Newfoundland and Labrador

Nomination Process

To nominate a candidate, go to www.cpsnl.ca > About > [Council Elections](#) and complete the Nomination Package. The completed package must include:

1. Completed nomination form
 - Nomination by two physicians who live or work in the appropriate medical electoral division, and
 - Acceptance of the nomination by the candidate
2. Candidate biography

Submit the completed Nomination Package (nomination form and biography) to elections@cpsnl.ca.

The deadline for nominations is Friday, November 3, 2023, at 12:30 pm

Voting

If there are more candidates than available seats, the College will hold an election conducted by an online voting system.

The College will forward the names and biographies of candidates and instructions regarding the online voting system to College members on November 7, 2023.
