

2024 Council Elections Call for Nominations

Greetings College Members,

The College is holding an election from November 6 to December 1, 2024, to fill four (4) seats on Council in accordance with the *Medical Act, 2011*. Nominations will be open until 12:30 pm on November 1, 2024. If you are interested in this opportunity, please see below for details.

The College values diversity, equity and inclusion and encourages underrepresented members to apply.

Medical electoral division seats:

- two (2) seats in the region of the City of Mount Pearl and the City of St. John's
- two (2) seats in the remainder of the province

Nomination Window: October 16 to November 1, 2024, at 12:30 pm

Who is eligible to run and vote?

To be eligible to run for election and vote for a candidate, a physician must hold a current Licence to Practice Medicine in Newfoundland and Labrador.

Nomination Process

To nominate a candidate, go to www.cpsnl.ca > About > Council Elections and complete the Nomination Package. The completed package must include:

- 1. Completed nomination form
 - Nomination by two physicians who live or work in the appropriate medical electoral division
 - Acceptance of the nomination by the candidate
- 2. Completed candidate biography

Submit the completed Nomination Package (nomination form and biography) to elections@cpsnl.ca.

Voting

If there are more candidates than available seats, the College will hold an election conducted by an online voting system. The College will forward the names and biographies of candidates and instructions regarding the online voting system to College members on November 5, 2024.
