



# Adjudication Tribunals Tariff of Costs & Witness Fees

## College By-Law

In accordance with the College's By-Law 6: Adjudication Tribunal Findings and Proceedings, the following sets out a tariff of the costs of the College for expenses incurred by the College for the hearing of a complaint before an Adjudication Tribunal and the fees to be paid to witnesses who are summoned to testify.

### Tariff of Costs

The College adopts this tariff of costs, setting out the College's costs of conducting disciplinary hearings. An Adjudication Tribunal may use this tariff as guidance for establishing the monetary value of an award of costs of the College at a hearing of a complaint before an Adjudication Tribunal.

First day of a disciplinary hearing (or any part thereof)	\$10,000
Second and any subsequent day(s) of a hearing (full day)	\$7,500
Second and any subsequent day(s) of a hearing (1/2 day)	\$3,000
Preliminary/interim application not heard as part of a hearing day (full day)	\$5,000
Preliminary/interim application not heard as part of a hearing day (1/2 day)	\$3,000

### Witness Fees

Consistent with the Rules of the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador, witnesses who are summoned to testify at a hearing before an Adjudication Tribunal are paid a fee in accordance with the following schedule of fees. Witnesses will also be reimbursed for necessary expenses in accordance with the College's Travel and Business Expense Policy.

Witnesses summoned to testify at a hearing (per day)	\$50
Witnesses summoned to testify at a hearing in relation to matters relating to their profession (per day) <sup>1</sup>	\$100
