



# CPSNL Complaints Authorization Committee – Call for Interest

The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Newfoundland and Labrador (CPSNL) is seeking expressions of interest from registrants who wish to be considered for appointment to the Complaints Authorization Committee (CAC) on an ad hoc basis as needed to assist in reviewing complaints in the areas of *OB/GYN*, *Psychiatry*, and *General Surgery*.

## **About the CAC:**

The CAC reviews and investigates complaints about registrants' professional conduct. Its role is to determine if there are reasonable grounds to believe the registrant has engaged in misconduct and to take steps to protect the public interest while ensuring fairness to the registrant.

## **Role and expectations:**

Applicants must be practicing medicine in either OB/GYN, Psychiatry or General Surgery. Skills in critical thinking, impartial decision-making, and understanding of professional regulation are valued.

Meetings are held virtually and take place during business hours and may vary in length. Members who serve on the CAC are remunerated for their service in accordance with CPSNL's reimbursement policy.

To qualify for appointment, a CPSNL Registrant must **NOT**:

- have had their licence to practice revoked or suspended in the previous 10 years.
- be subject to any pending disciplinary proceedings before the College or another medical regulatory authority.
- hold or have held, within one year before the date of the appointment, another position which would cause the Registrant, if appointed as a CAC Member, to have a conflict of interest.
