Deputy Registrar

The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Newfoundland and Labrador (CPSNL) is seeking to fill the position of Deputy Registrar.

Reporting to the CEO and Registrar, the Deputy Registrar is a crucial member of CPSNL's leadership team. The role serves primarily as the organization's Medical Advisor providing strategic medical expertise to leadership on policy, regulatory decisions, complex matters, and stakeholder engagement. They oversee and coordinate the work of CPSNL's Medical Advisors, identifying work, ensuring coverage, and providing coordination across advisors to ensure the overall quality and timeliness of medical expertise and guidance. They provide strategic and leadership support to Committees of Council as needed. The Deputy Registrar also has operational responsibility for Communications, overseeing the work of the Communications team and ensuring appropriate alignment and delivery. This role is estimated at .6 or .8 of a full-time role and will require work and meeting attendance outside normal business hours.
