CPSNL will be holding a Council Election on December 1, 2025. The voting window will be open from November 5, 2025, at 12:30 p.m. until 4:30 p.m., December 1, 2025. The composition of Council, as detailed in the *Medical Act, 2011*, was recently changed to ensure more diverse geographic representation. An outline of the elected members representation is provided with this notice.

There are three (3) vacant seats in the upcoming Council Election that must go to active CPSNL Registrants that live or practice in those regions:

- one (1) seat in Health Region 1 (Eastern Urban)
- one (1) seat in Health Region 2, 4 or 5 (Eastern Rural, Western, or Labrador-Grenfell)
- one (1) seat in Health Region 2, 4 or 5 (Eastern Rural, Western, or Labrador-Grenfell)

Serving on the CPSNL Council is a challenging and rewarding commitment that requires time and participation in Council and Committee meetings. Council members are remunerated for attending Council and Committee meetings and any required travel is covered in accordance with CPSNL's travel and business expense policy.

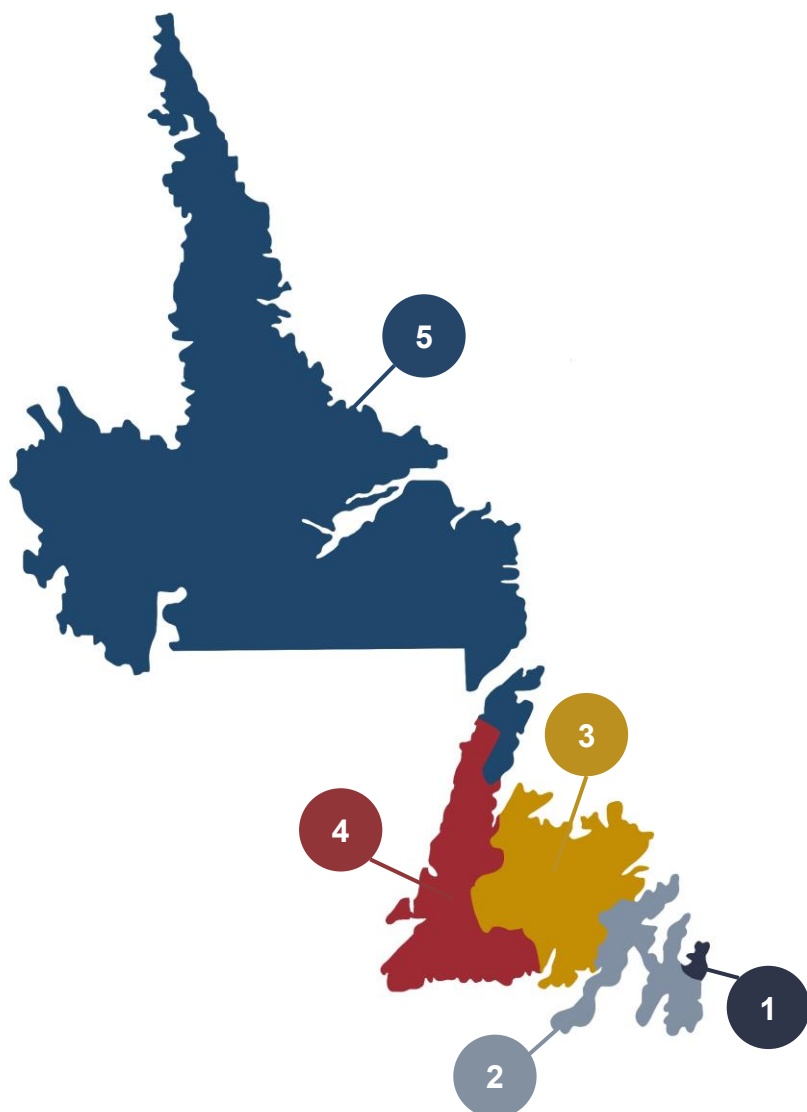

Health Region 1 (Eastern Urban)	3
Health Region 2 (Eastern Rural)	1
Health Region 3 (Central)	1
Health Region 4 (Western)	1
Health Region 5 (Labrador-Grenfell)	1



Health Region 1 (Eastern Urban): from the Town of Conception Bay South inclusive in the west and the Town of Witless Bay inclusive in the southeast to the Town of Pouch Cove inclusive in the north, but does not include Bell Island

Health Region 2 (Eastern Rural): the Avalon Peninsula that is not included in Region 1, Bell Island and the Bonavista and Burin Peninsulas extending to Port Blandford inclusive

Health Region 3 (Central): from Charlottetown inclusive in the east, Fogo Island in the northeast, Harbour Breton/the Connaigre Peninsula in the south to the Baie Verte Peninsula in the west

Health Region 4 (Western): extends from Port aux Basques on the southwest coast to Francois, northwest to Bartlett's Harbour inclusive and on the eastern boundary north to Jackson's Arm inclusive

Health Region 5 (Labrador-Grenfell): the area north of Bartlett's Harbour and north of Englee inclusive on the Northern Peninsula and all of Labrador
