



Canadian Trained Route to Licensure Policy

All applicants must meet the minimum certification and examination requirements applicable to their discipline of practice to be eligible for a Licence to Practice Medicine in Newfoundland and Labrador.

Scope:

This policy applies to all applicants for a Licence to Practice Medicine who completed their postgraduate training program within Canada.

Policy:

In addition to satisfying all other licensing requirements, an applicant who completed discipline appropriate postgraduate training in Canada may be eligible for a Licence to Practice Medicine if they meet the following certification and examination requirements:

Family Medicine Practice

- a. Full Licence:
 - i. College of Family Physicians of Canada Certification (CCFP), **or** Collège des Médecins du Québec (CMQ) certification; **and**
 - ii. Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada (LMCC) or [acceptable alternative](#)
- b. Provisional Licence:
 - i. CCFP or CMQ Certification; **or**
 - ii. Medical Council of Canada Qualifying Examination (MCCQE) Part I or [acceptable alternative](#)

Specialty Practice

- a. Full Licence:
 - i. Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) Certification; **and**
 - ii. LMCC or [acceptable alternative](#)
- b. Provisional Licence
 - i. RCPSC Certification; **or**
 - ii. RCPSC examination eligibility and MCCQE Part I or [acceptable alternative](#)
