

The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Newfoundland and Labrador

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Examinations Required and Approved by Council

This policy outlines the examinations acceptable to the Council for registration.

Scope:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the examinations which meet the eligibility requirements set out in the *Medical Regulations, 2023,* for all licence types.

Policy:

To qualify for registration in Newfoundland and Labrador, applicants are required to obtain a score satisfactory to the Council in any examination required and approved by Council. The following are the required examinations and acceptable alternatives to the examinations:
