We are starting a small Public Experience Advisory Group to bring the perspectives of patients, caregivers, families, and members of the public into our work.

Your feedback will help shape new practice standards, guidelines, and public information. No medical background is needed.

Why take part?

- Receive training and support.
- Be paid for your time and advice.

What you will do

- Review short materials before meetings.
- Join online meetings about every three months, during the day or evening.
- Share thoughts, questions, and suggestions from a public point of view.
- Personal healthcare experiences matter. This group is focused on improving future work, not resolving individual complaints or specific past experiences.

Pay

- \$100–150 per session, including preparation and meeting time.
- \$200 for one training session before your first meeting.

Who can apply

Anyone with experience using healthcare in Newfoundland and Labrador, including patients, family members, caregivers, and others who have helped someone use healthcare.
